Your Vaccine Coverage

Navitus MedicareRx (PDP) is committed to your health. Your prescription benefit covers Medicare **Part D** vaccinations to prevent illness. Navitus covers the following common vaccines, which are available at a \$0 cost to you at a participating pharmacy. It is always recommended to check with your prescriber to see which vaccinations are right for you.

- Shingles
- Hepatitis A and Hepatitis B (for members at low risk)
- Travel vaccines (including typhoid, yellow fever, Rabies, Japanese Encephalitis, and Polio)
- Tetanus (for preventative use)
- Meningitis

Please note that some common vaccines are covered by your <u>Medicare Part B</u> benefit. These include influenza (flu), pneumonia, COVID-19, tetanus (for injury or exposure) and hepatitis *B* (for members at medium or high risk of hepatitis). Please contact your Medicare **Part B** plan for more information.

How to Receive Your Part D Vaccinations

We recommend scheduling your Part D vaccinations at an in-network pharmacy. These pharmacies can bill directly to Navitus MedicareRx for a quick, easy, no-cost appointment.

Part D vaccinations may also be covered by Medicare at your provider's office. You can ask us to reimburse you for our share of the cost. To do this, submit vaccination records along with payment receipts to Navitus MedicareRx.
